

March 1 Underway in accordance NOIC NAPLES 241549A of February escorting U.S.S. GENERAL M.C. MEIGS to position 09° W. Long. 0245 Detached from U.S.S. GENERAL M.C. MEIGS by her dispatch 281543 February. Proceeding to ORAN, ALGERIA in accordance FOGMA dispatch 281045A February.

0800 position 34°-52'N 07°-56'W 1300 Passed thru STRAITS OF GIBRALTAR. 2000 position 35°-49'N 04°-06'W

March	30	Anchored as before. 1700 Underway in accordance COMMANDER FLANK FORCE dispatch 301011A in company with H.M.S. MILNE and H.M.S. METEOR to conduct defensive patrol in GULF OF GENOA.
